

New jobs fair for Australia & New Zealand comes to Dublin

The dream of a new life in Australia or New Zealand could soon become a reality, as a new recruitment fair for downunder comes to Dublin on the 2<sup>nd</sup> February.

Australia needs skilled workers; an estimated 500,000 in Western Australia alone, as the resources boom continues to create job opportunities across the state. In New Zealand, the Christchurch earthquake requires skilled migrants to help rebuild the city, and as both countries seek skilled workers, there are real opportunities for Irish workers.
